NOTES FOR THE INFORMATION OF APPLICANTS

1. The application form, fully completed should be addressed to:
“E.S.S. Section, State Examinations Commission, Cornamaddy, Athlone” and should reach the Commission not later than **03rd May, 2019**.
2. **Canvassing will disqualify.**
3. Postage must be prepaid on all applications.
4. An Irish version of this form is available on request from the State Examinations Commission.
5. Failure to quote P.P.S.N. number or complete all questions on this form will result in your application being returned for completion and it may be subsequently treated as a late entry if received after the closing date.
6. Appointment as examiner in any given year does not confer the right to appointment in subsequent years.
7. A per capita examining fee € 5.59 (Ordinary Level) € 7.74 (Higher Level) } will be paid.
8. Where the work is being examined by the class teacher/another teacher in the school the work will be carried out during the month of May.
9. Where the work is being examined by a visiting examiner, the work will be carried out during the period 5th – 21st June 2019.
10. Monitoring will take place in the period 5th – 21st June 2019.
11. All examiners (class teacher/another teacher in the school/visiting examiners) and advising examiners will receive detailed briefing. Substitution will be approved for necessary absences in connection with this briefing.
12. Travelling expenses and subsistence allowances will be paid in accordance with Department of Finance regulations.
13. All applicants **must** be registered with the Teaching Council – see hereunder.

Teaching Council Registration

Aspects of The National Vetting Bureau (Children and Vulnerable Persons) Bill 2012 are due for commencement prior to the 2014 examinations. It is now mandatory that all those undertaking the position of Oral/Practical Examiner for the 2014 examinations and subsequent years are registered on the Register of Teachers maintained by the Teaching Council.

What to do if I am registered?

Complete your registration details - registration number, name as it appears on the register and renewal date - on the application form. The SEC will validate the registration details against the register. Please ensure that you complete these details as failure to do so may delay processing your application. **If you are registered at the time of applying and are subsequently appointed, it is your responsibility to ensure that your registration does not lapse and that you are registered at the time of the examinations in March/April.**

What to do if I am not registered?

Complete the application form for the position of Oral/Practical Examiner in the normal way but indicate that you are not registered. Return the form to the SEC in normal way. However, you must also **apply immediately** to the Teaching Council for registration and have the registration details submitted before the appointments are made in the case of oral examiners from January 2019 and practical examiners from March 2019.

Important Information about the Registration Process

It is each applicant's own responsibility to ensure that they are on the Register of Teachers and to provide the SEC with their registration number, when requested. The registration process, which includes a process of Garda Vetting, may take 6 -8 weeks once all required documentation has been received. Applicants are advised to apply for registration immediately. For administrative reasons, the SEC requires all potential applicants for examining positions in the 2019 exams to be registered in the case of oral examiners from January 2010 and practical examiners from March 2019

The State Examinations Commission accepts no liability for teacher registration fees or for any applicant's inability to meet the registration and vetting requirement within the specified timeframe.
